



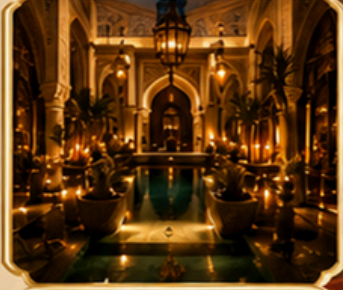

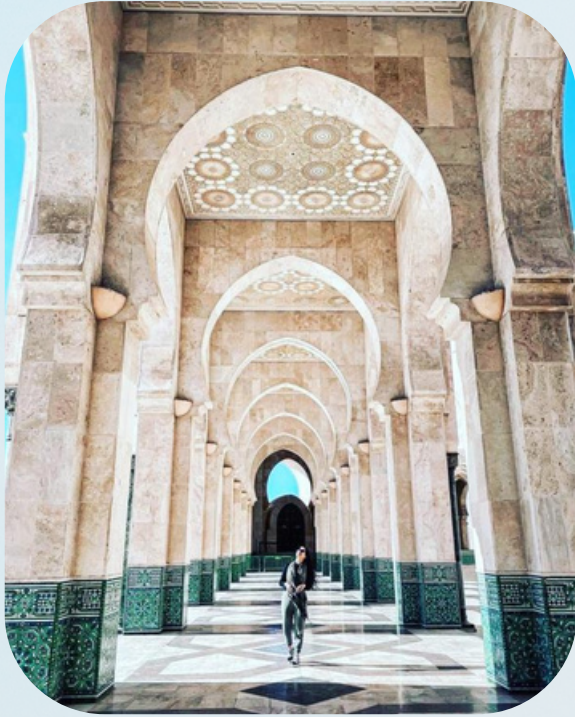

DAY 1 Arrival in Casablanca

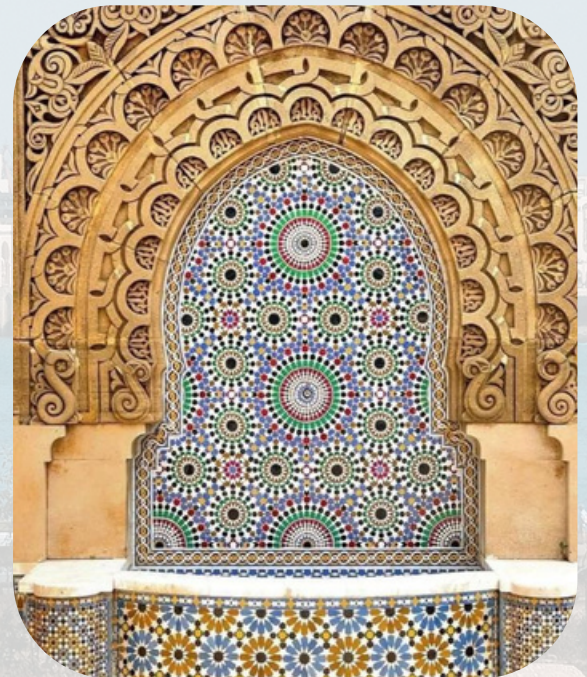
Upon arrival in Casablanca, the economic capital of Morocco, you will be met by your private Minibus and transferred to your hotel, where you will check in and relax for the afternoon. Depending on time, you could choose to have an optional tour of the Hassan II Mosque. It is one of the largest Mosques in the world and its hand-crafted beauty is breathtaking.

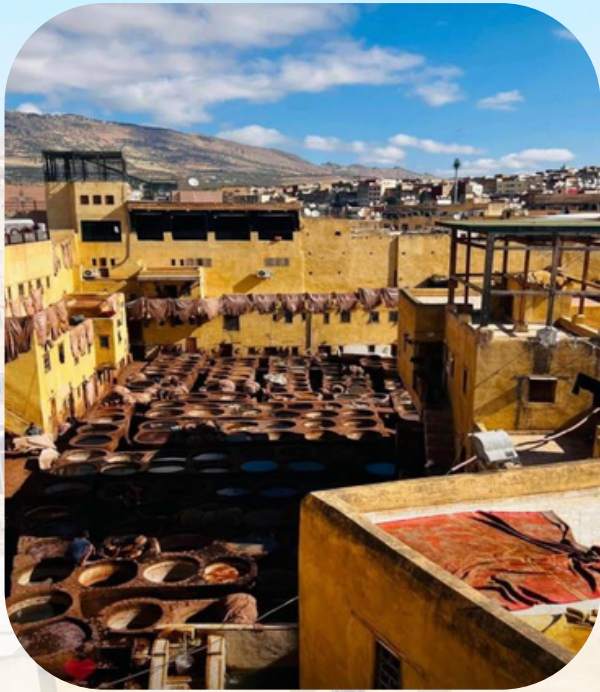
DAY 2 Casablanca – Rabat – Meknes – Fez

After breakfast, you will leave with your driver towards Fes, the spiritual and scientific capital city. On route, you will stop at Rabat, the capital city and residence of the royal family. You will visit to this Imperial city, the Hassan Tower and tomb of the two kings Hassan II and Mohammed V, Chellah and Kasbah Oudaya.... After lunch, we drive to meknes and volubilis to explore the Roman Ruins and will continue on to Fes. Dinner will be served at the traditional local riad or hotel.

DAY 3 Fez (City Tour)



After breakfast you will begin your private guided tour of the Medina, one of the world's largest walled in cities. You will explore the narrow streets lined with fresh fruit, mounds of spices, many other arts objects of Morocco. A visit to the Royal Palace, the tanneries, and potters are just a few places you will experience. For lunch you will eat in traditional restaurant in the heart of the Medina. After lunch you will complete the tour and Return to the hotel to prepare for a sumptuous dinner at a traditional restaurant in Old Medina.

DAY 4 Fes – Atlas Mountains – Midelt – Erfoud

After an early breakfast our adventure start today to explore the magic of the desert, you will begin your ascent across the Middle Atlas Mountains. Most of the day will be spent winding your way through the beautiful forests, in our way we'll visit Ifran city Switzerland of morocco, and Berber villages as you cross the Atlas Mountains and begin to descend towards the Sahara Desert. Halfway, you will stop for lunch in the town of Midelt, famous for its mineral and rocks. Then we will be going through ziz valley. On the evening will arrival at the Kasbah in Erfoud. Dinner will be served in the Kasbah.

DAY 5 Erfoud – Rissani – Merzouga Desert

In the morning, our long-awaited day will begin the wedding day and the grand celebration. We will make a brief visit to Erfoud, the gateway to the Sahara, exploring its old and traditional market and the city's museum of archaeology and natural fossils. Afterwards, we will head to a small, quiet village to begin the wedding festivities with local Moroccan music in a truly familial atmosphere. The women will begin applying henna designs, surrounded by men in traditional dress, with music playing continuously. Tea and sweets will be served until lunchtime. After lunch, we will travel in 4×4 vehicles towards the Merzouga desert, where the grand celebration and wedding ceremony await us. There, amidst the sands, a romantic and legendary event awaits us in a beautiful setting filled with decorations, lights, tables laden with food and drinks of all kinds, and local and Western music, including a local band. The festivities will begin early, before sunset, allowing us to enjoy the beautiful atmosphere until midnight, when we will celebrate the final moments of the beautiful wedding celebration.

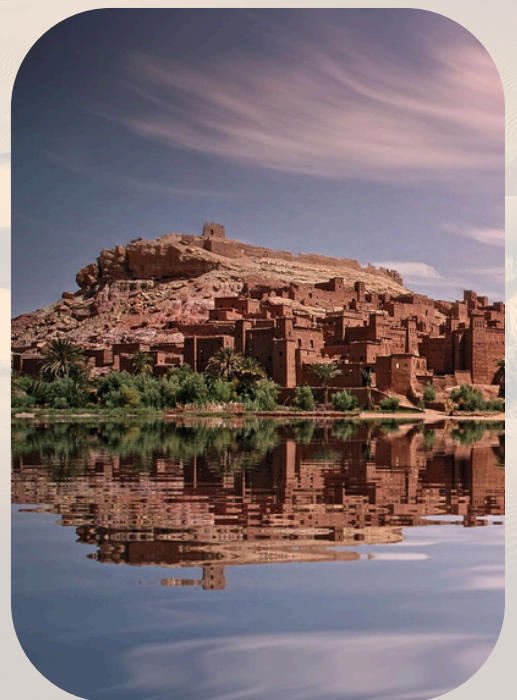
Note: On the day 6, the newlyweds' honeymoon will begin with them being escorted to their destination and their own program.

DAY 6 Merzouga Desert – Toudra gorges - Ouarzazet (Honeymoon Couple):

On this day, your honeymoon trip will begin, and you will continue your journey away from the group.

After breakfast, you will set off behind the High Atlas Mountains on the route to Ouarzazate. Along the way, you may enjoy a walk through the towering Todra Gorges, which rise 600 feet high near the city of Tinghir. After lunch, you will continue across the oasis of the Dadès Valley, surrounded by palm groves. In the evening, you will arrive at your hotel in Ouarzazate.

DAY 6 Merzouga Desert – Toudra gorges – Dades gorges (Group):

DAY 7 Dades – Kasbah ait Benhadou - Marrakech (Group):

After breakfast we head to the Red City, the City of Palms, the City of Seven Gates, to Marrakech. On the way you will visit one of the jewels of Morocco ‘Kasbah Ait Benhaddou’. In typical Moroccan fashion, the true treasures must be searched out and discovered...usually off the beaten path. In actuality, this setting has been used for more films than any other location in Morocco; films including, Lawrence of Arabia, Jesus of Nazareth, and The Gladiator. Once in Marrakech, you will check into your riad or hotel and then head off to the Jemaa el-Fna, the center square of the Medina. The famous Jamaa el Fna is one of the center attractions of Marrakech. Coming alive at night with the local storytellers, entertainers, and mouth-watering barbeque pits, the square is well worth a visit. A quiet cup of tea on the terrace of an adjacent café provides a spectacular panoramic view of the bustling square. Dinner will be served at the Riad or hotel.

DAY 8 Agadir Relaxing the Beach(Honeymoon Couple):

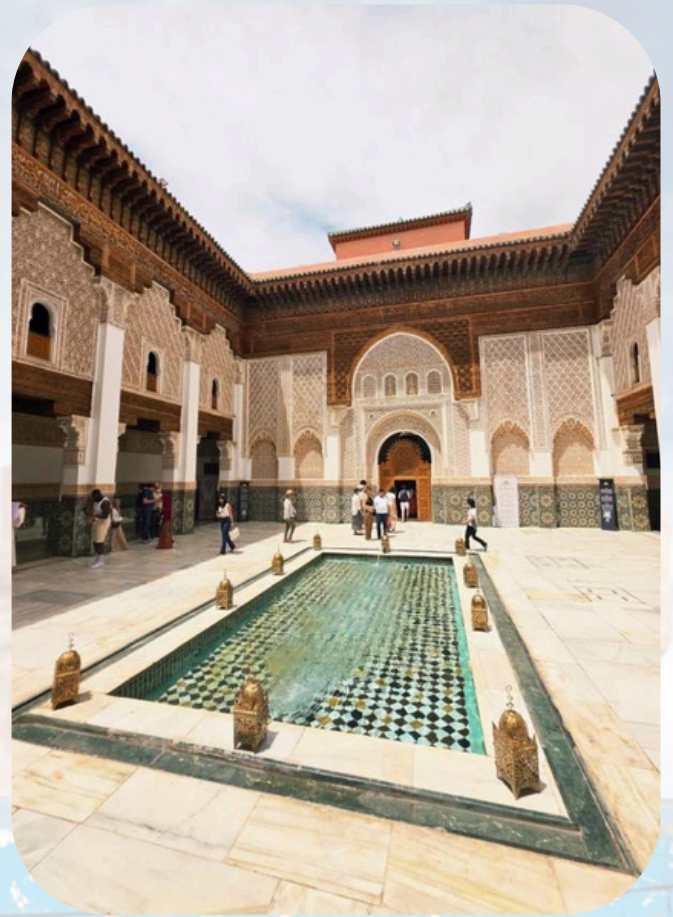

DAY 8 Marrakech (City Tour)(Group):

After breakfast, you will spend the whole day with private guide for visiting Marrakech,” known also as the “red city” for its red mud brick buildings. DAY 9 Marrakech – Essaouira (Day Trip)(Group):

After breakfast at the hotel, we drive west towards Essaouira MOGADOR, a charming town well known for its artisans who produce unique handicrafts. The city suddenly appears over a great rocky peninsula, with its white walls, blue doors and windows. The beauty of it all, the softness of colours and light, the fresh climate in the summer creates an ambience that reins it. You will get the lunch of soft fish near of the beach of medina. Essaouira is where the sea and the dreams are infinite, where ancient stories are marked on the small port, on the fort of Vauban, and the labyrinth of streets hide so many tales.

DAY 10 Essaouira - Marrakech(Honeymoon Couple):

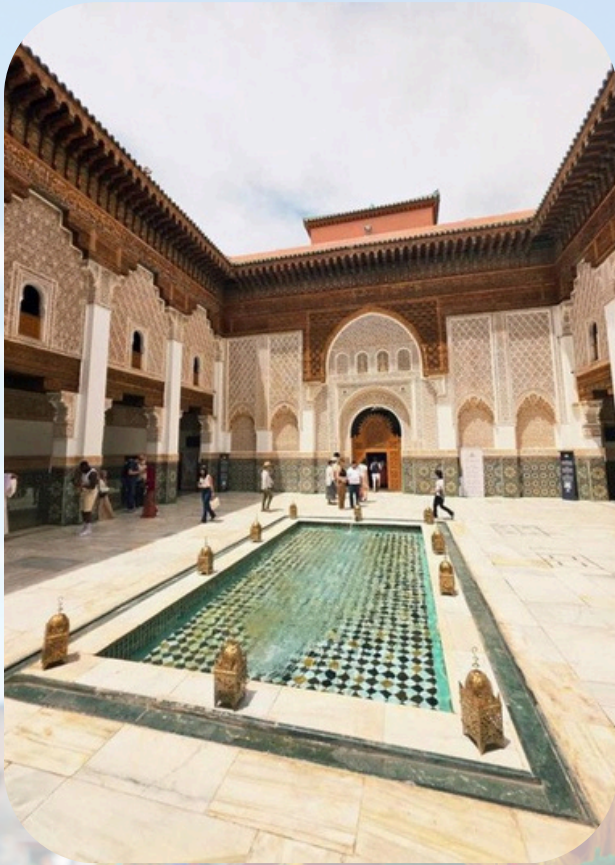
After breakfast we head to the Red City, the City of Palms, the City of Seven Gates, to Marrakech.
